A registered medical practitioner practising medicine in the State, as a candidate for election in accordance with the provisions of section 17(1)(f) and (8) of the Medical Practitioners Act, 2007.

Pursuant to Statutory Instrument No 22 of 2013, a candidate may not, in the same election, stand for election in more than one of the six descriptions of medical practitioner referred to in section 17(8) of the Act. Accordingly, if the Returning Officer has received a duly completed nomination paper for a candidate for election, in one of those descriptions of medical practitioner, the Returning Officer shall reject all subsequent nomination papers for that candidate in any other of those descriptions of medical practitioner received by the Returning Officer (including any such nomination papers received on the same day as the first mentioned nomination paper).

*Instructions

 - A medical practitioner registered or able to be registered in the Specialist Division in relation to **anaesthesia**
 - A medical practitioner registered or able to be registered in the Specialist Division in relation to **public health medicine**
 - A medical practitioner registered or able to be registered in the Specialist Division in relation to **pathology or radiology**
 - A registered medical practitioner, **not being a consultant, practicing medicine in a hospital**
 - A registered medical practitioner, **not falling within any of the categories** above

Candidates nominated should demonstrate relevant experience or skills in at least one of the following areas: corporate governance, risk management, strategy development, change management, regulation, and health sector knowledge. They should also show effective judgement, have effective communication skills, and be improvement focussed.

All candidates validly nominated, standing for election, will be requested to provide a short biography for publication on the Medical Council website, in association with the election.



Section 6(1) of the Statutory Instruments No. 22 of 2013:-

“Ineligibility of candidates for nomination:-

A registered medical practitioner is deemed to be ineligible to become a candidate for election to the Council if the person-

- (a) has served as a member of the Council for two consecutive terms or more,
- (b) is a member of either House of the Oireachtas or of the European Parliament or of a local authority,
- (c) has been adjudged bankrupt,
- (d) has made a composition or arrangement with creditors,
- (e) has been convicted of an indictable offence,
- (f) has been convicted of an offence involving fraud or dishonesty,
- (g) has been the subject of an order under sections 838, 842 and 850 of the Companies Act 2014
- (h) has been sentenced to a term of imprisonment by a Court of competent jurisdiction, or
- (i) has been removed by a competent authority for any reason (other than failure to pay a fee) from a register established for the purpose of registering members of a profession in the State or in another jurisdiction.

Submission of Nominations for Election

Each completed nomination form **must be** accompanied by the completed declaration of consent form and returned to the Returning Officer who will attend at the Medical Council, Kingram House, Kingram Place, Dublin 2 D02 XY88 to receive nomination papers on **16th February, 2018** between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 1.00 p.m., after which time the receipt of nominations will close.

Nomination forms can be returned prior to this date and every nomination paper delivered for the attention of the Returning Officer (at the above address) before the commencement of the above hours, shall be retained and produced by the Returning Officer and be deemed to have been delivered at the beginning of these hours.
