Trainee doctors' decision to leave is linked with poor experience of training at clinical sites

say they will not be practising medicine in Ireland in the future

Factors associated with wanting to leave medical practice

**Older trainees
(35 - 39 year olds)**

most likely to leave medical practice in Ireland

43%

of trainees with a limiting illness, disability or health issue are considering leaving medical practice in Ireland

20 - 24 year olds

most likely to practise medicine in Ireland in the future

35%

of trainees who were bullied intend to leave medical practice in Ireland
