Findings of the Committee:

The Committee having heard the evidence decided, to exercise its discretion to invoke Section 67 of the 2007 Act in accordance with the following terms :-

- Not to repeat the conduct the subject of the complaint pursuant to section 67(1)(a) of the Act;
- To undertake a course in medical ethics, acceptable to the Medical Council;
- Dr. Ranga's consent to being censured by the Council.

The reason in reaching its decision to make this request was the early admission of the truth of the facts alleged. The insight and remorse displayed in relation to their own conduct, that this was a single isolated incident, which took place in the context of a friendship. Fortunately, that there were no issues of patient safety or danger to the public arising from this particular incident.

The Committee were satisfied that there will be no repetition of their behaviours, and the Committee also took in account the testimonials provided by Dr. Ranga and also the steps already taken by Dr. Ranga to remediate his conduct to date.
