Findings of the Committee:

Allegation 1:

That Dr Endredi failed to make an adequate record of the consultation with Mr Geraghty.

Having regard to the evidence adduced, the Committee found that :

Allegation 1 was proven as to fact.

Reason: The Committee finds that there was broad agreement between Professor Bradley and Dr Peter Wahrab, that the record of the consultation with Mr Geraghty was inadequate and imperfect respectively.

Allegation 1 did not amount to poor professional performance.

Reason: The Committee was not satisfied that the conduct was proven to be poor performance beyond a reasonable doubt.

Allegation 2:

That Dr Endredi failed to take an adequate history from Mr Geraghty.

Allegation 2 was not proven as to fact beyond a reasonable doubt.

Allegation 3:

That Dr Endredi failed to carry out adequate examinations and/or adequate investigations in respect of Mr Geraghty.

Allegation 3 was not proven as to fact beyond a reasonable doubt.

Allegation 4:

That Dr Endredi diagnosed Mr Geraghty as suffering from an upper airways infection and/or drug and/or alcohol withdrawal syndrome one or both of which were inconsistent with his clinical findings.

Allegation 4 was struck out on application.

Allegation 5:

That Dr Endredi failed to give any or adequate consideration to Mr Geraghty's cardiovascular history.

Allegation 5 was not proven as to fact beyond a reasonable doubt.

Allegation 6:

That Dr Endredi failed to give any or adequate consideration to a possible diagnosis of myocardial ischaemia.

Allegation 6 was not proven as to fact beyond a reasonable doubt.

Allegation 7:

That Dr Endredi failed to refer Mr Geraghty to hospital and or failed to give any or adequate consideration to referring Mr Geraghty to hospital.

Allegation 7 was not proven as to fact beyond a reasonable doubt.
