**Allegation 1:**

This allegation was withdrawn by the CEO

The evidence of Mr Ciaran Quinn established this beyond a reasonable doubt.

Allegation 3 did amount to professional misconduct.

Reason:

The evidence established beyond a reasonable doubt that this failure was a falling short of the standard of conduct expected among doctors.
