



**Findings of the Fitness to Practise Committee
following an Inquiry held pursuant to Part 8
of the Medical Practitioners Act 2007**

Findings of the Committee:

Allegation 1:

That Dr El-Mana, failed to comply with the following condition which was attached to your registration following perfection of a High Court Order on 18 October 2010:

“That you undertake a course in professionalism, acceptable to the Medical Council, within 6 months of the date from which these conditions become effective and forward a copy of your results to the Medical Council.”

Having regard to the evidence adduced, the Committee found that :

Allegation 1 was proven as to fact.

Reason: The Committee firstly note that the Dr El-Mana completed a course entitled "Introduction to Leadership and Management" as provided by the RCPI in March 2012 as notified by the doctor to the Medical Council on 20th July, 2012. No evidence was given about whether the course was acceptable to the Medical Council. However at this stage the 6 months referred to in the High Court Order perfected on 18th October, 2010 had long since expired and despite the indulgence given by the Monitoring Group until 6th October, 2011 the doctor failed to comply with the condition of the High Court Order.

Allegation 1 did amount to a failure to comply with a relevant condition attached to his registration.

Reason: Dr El-Mana clearly did not comply with the condition of the High Court Order.

Other matters relating to the registered medical practitioner the subject of the complaint which the Committee considers appropriate to specify:

The Committee is concerned with the non-engagement by Dr El-Mana with the Medical Council and it's Committees including this Fitness to Practise Committee. A doctor whilst in a learning phase or otherwise must engage with competent regulatory authorities when directed by a Court or the Authority.

The Committee notes that no evidence was offered as to whether the course undertaken by Dr El-Mana was acceptable to the Medical Council.
